DIPIC110 Intercultural Communication

Overview of the module

Intercultural communication offers the ability to relate across cultures which is increasingly important as there are more and more opportunities for contact with people from different cultures. Through listening, discussions, readings and observation tasks, this course will help you better understand cross-cultural complexity as you cultivate awareness of your own and others' cultures and the values that underlie them, recognize some of the important differences in communication styles, and build your intercultural competence all while developing your English language skills.

Key questions explored on the course

- What is culture and how does it influence my life?
- How can we learn about other cultures including elements 'below the surface'? In doing this, how can we avoid stereotyping?
- In what ways may communication and body language be influenced by culture? How might cultural orientations, dimensions and values underlie different behaviors?
- Why is it important to become aware of my own cultural identity in order to be more interculturally competent? How interculturally competent am I?

Skills

This module will help you improve your English language skills with a special emphasis on:

- recognising the role of background knowledge, context, topic, and purpose in listening and reading
- understanding main ideas in listening and reading and separating them from specific details
- taking effective notes in listening, reading and observation situations according to the given purpose
- using cross-cultural knowledge and observation skills to behave and speak in a culturally appropriate manner; recognising cultural differences such as body language
- expressing ideas clearly and accurately in speaking

Performance Tasks

Throughout the module you will:

- listen, read and discuss topics related to intercultural communication
- write regularly in a reflection journal
- observe yourself, others in your culture, and those in other cultures
- participate in and then reflect on role plays and simulations to raise awareness of intercultural differences
