Overview of the module

In this module, you will learn to develop confidence in discussing and expressing your opinions about a variety of issues by learning how to analyse topics, identify stakeholders, and examine issues through different lenses. You will then use these skills to participate in both formal and informal debates in which you will construct arguments and counterarguments. Spoken English language skills will focus specifically on techniques for participating in academic discussions and presenting logical and well-supported arguments.

- How can I construct and use questions in order to deepen my understanding of a topic?
- How can I use a variety of perspectives to understand complex issues?
- What is the best way to build an effective argument?
- How can I identify and respond to logical fallacies?
